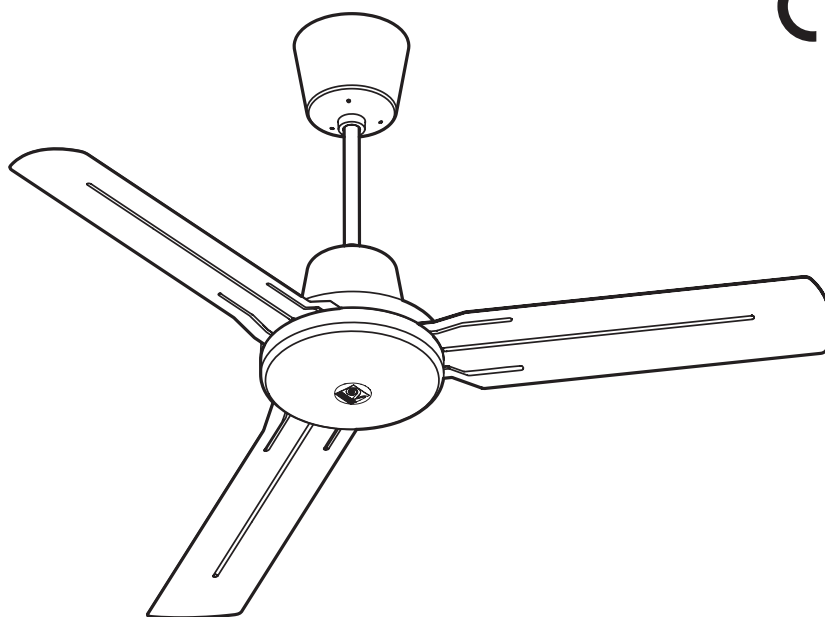

Description and use

The product you have purchased is a ceiling agitator/fan, IPX5 (fig.1).



Warning:
this symbol indicates that care must be taken to avoid injury to the user

- Do not use this product for functions other than those described in the instruction booklet.
- After having removed the product from its packing, ensure that it is complete and undamaged: if in doubt contact Vortice Service Centre.
- Do not leave packaging within the reach of children or differently able persons.
- Certain fundamental rules must be observed when using any electrical appliance:
 - Never touch appliances with wet or damp hands
 - Never touch appliances while barefoot
- If using this appliance where there are children, supervision by an adult is necessary; this appliance must not be used, without assistance, by children or persons whose physical, sensory or mental capacities prevent them from applying the necessary safety precautions.
- Do not use the appliance where flammable vapours are present (spirit, insecticides, petrol, etc.).
- The lower section of the blade should raise from the floor (Fig.2) by at least 2.30 metres, in accordance with the provisions of the current laws in force.
- Unauthorised changes to the factory set fittings shall invalidate the guarantee and entitle the manufacturer to disclaim any whatsoever liability.

- Do not make modifications of any kind to this appliance.
- The appliance must not be exposed to atmospheric conditions (rain, sun, etc.).
- The appliance must be installed by a professionally qualified person.
- Regularly inspect the appliance for visible defects. If any faults are found, do not operate the appliance but contact Vortice Service Centre.
- The electrical mains to which the unit is connected must conform to current standard.
- The appliance must be properly connected to an electrical system in compliance with the applicable regulations and equipped with an efficient earthing system. If in doubt, have a qualified electrician perform a thorough check.
- The electrical power source to which the product is to be connected must be able to provide the maximum amount of electrical power required by the product. If it cannot do this, contact an electrician for appropriate remedial action.
- Use a multi-polar switch with minimum contact gaps of 3 mm when installing the appliance.

- Should the appliance be dropped or suffer a heavy blow, have it checked immediately by Vortice.
- If the appliance does not function correctly or develops a fault, turn it off and contact Vortice immediately. Ensure that only genuine original Vortice spares are used for any repairs.
- Do not leave the appliance on unnecessarily: when the appliance is not in use, turn the switch to off.
- Use the unit at an ambient temperature not above 40°C (104°F).
- Place the unit at a suitable distance from walls, objects, etc.
- Specifications for the power supply must correspond to the electrical data on data plate A (fig.3).

Installation

1. Check that the intended ceiling is structurally suited to support the weight of the product.
2. Pay attention that the anchoring devices do not jeopardize the structural strength of the intended ceiling.
3. Use correctly tightened anchoring devices suited to the weight of the product and to the type of the ceiling.

Cleaning

Before cleaning the unit or carrying out maintenance operations turn the main switch off and remove the plug from the power supply.

Important information on eco-compatible disposal
